That said, this is the perfect introduction for someone wanting to get into hand cut joinery. In fact, it is a variation of a test you will likely get assigned while studying at a Furniture Making School that focuses on hand craft.

You can make this test as difficult or as easy as you would like by either starting with planed timber or starting with rough timber. Alternatively you could:

- Limit the amount of tools you use.
- Use woods that are more challenging to work than others.
- Set yourself a time limit
